#### Background Mesila has been actively involved in

financial crisis intervention for the past 15 years. Our original focus was on family counseling, but over time we expanded our educational efforts because we realized how much crisis can be averted through education. By way of illustration, it takes a few lessons to warn someone not to go into debt; it takes a community to dig someone out from under a mountain of debt - and sometimes even that is not enough.

In keeping with its mission of empowering families and communities to achieve financial stability, Mesila has developed educational programs to teach kids about financial literacy and health because we find that so much crisis and unhappiness can be averted if people are given these tools at an early stage.
